

PACKING TIPS

- **Packing takes time start packing well ahead of time, a few boxes a night or a room every few days really adds up.**
- **Use packing tape to seal every box top and bottom.**
- **Pack Heavy items in small boxes and light items in large boxes.**
- **Use towels and linens as packing materials for fragile items.**
- **Do not over-pack a box, too much weight or bulk can force a box open and spill the contents.**
- **Pack the heavier item at the bottom and the lighter items towards the top of the box.**
- **Wrap all breakables individually with lots of padding and mark the box Fragile to ensure special attention.**
- **It helps to mark each box by location to identify where it should be placed when moving into your home.**
- **Plates, flatware, records and books are best packed vertically in small boxes.**
- **Fill each box completely by stuffing crushed packing paper into empty spaces.**
- **A wardrobe box is perfect for suites, dresses and coats because it eliminates the trouble of dry cleaning when unpacked at your new home. We bring some Free on Moving Day,**
- **Dresser drawers can be left full and moved with the dresser but you should remove and pack separately all breakables and heavy items.**
- **Lampshades should be packed alone 2-3 in a box, separated by clean packing paper and marked fragile.**
- **Pictures and mirrors are best packed in a specially designed Picture/Mirror Box, or wrapped inside a large flattened box with both ends sealed.**
- **Toys and smaller loose items should be packed into a larger box.**
- **Drain gasoline from equipment and dispose of chemicals, aerosol cans, etc. to guard against damage that could be caused by combustion or leakage.**
